September 15th	Spring Graduate Graduation Application Due—The Graduate Graduation Application and \$35 fee must be submitted to the School of Graduate Studies. Applications received after this date are processed for the following semester.
April 20th	Deadline to complete oral examination/thesis or project defense in order to graduate during spring semester.
May 1st	All degree candidates who are required to complete a thesis must submit bound-ready copies and signed title pages to the School of Graduate Studies.
May 4th	Commencement <i>The Office of the Registrar will email information regarding the Commencement ceremony. It is very important to read and respond to email requests as it will affect participation in commencement.</i>
May 11th	All paperwork (signed Master Degree Plans, prospectus, oral examination) must be received in the School of Graduate Studies from each Graduate Program Director in order to graduate.

January 30th	<p>Summer Graduation Application Due—The Graduate Graduation Application and \$35 fee must be turned in to the School of Graduate Studies. Applications received after this date are processed for the following semester.</p> <p>Although there are no Graduate Hooding or Commencement ceremonies held during summer, you must still apply to graduate if your degree requirements are completed this semester.</p>
July 20th	<p>Deadline to complete oral examination/thesis or project defense in order to graduate during summer semester.</p>
July 26th	<p>All degree candidates who are required to complete a thesis must submit bound-ready copies and signed title pages to the School of Graduate Studies.</p>
July 27th	<p>All paperwork (signed Master Degree Plans, prospectus, oral examination) must be received in the School of Graduate Studies from each Graduate Program Director in order to graduate.</p>

November 28th	Deadline to complete oral examination/thesis or project in order to graduate during fall semester.
December 4th	All degree candidates who are required to complete a thesis must submit bound-ready copies and signed title pages to the School of Graduate Studies.
December 13th	All paperwork (signed Master Degree Plans, prospectus, oral examination) must be received in the School of Graduate Studies from each Graduate Program Director in order to graduate.
