<b>3.2 ECON 1101 Survey of Economics</b>	<b>3.2</b> N. Finlay presented the ECON 1101 course for approval. This course takes selected topics from ECON 2105 and 2106 and creates a survey course for non ECON majors and supports joint enrollment of students. 150 students are projected to take the course next semester. If for some reason students take ECON 2105/2106 at a later date, they would not receive credit for ECON 1101 and the upper level courses. There are plans for the course to be placed in Area E4 and be included in the core curriculum. A proposal for this will be presented in the near future.	<b>3.2</b> The proposal was tabled and will be presented at the next meeting. The UCC members requested that courses within the USG system be reviewed for similar content.
