



RESET 2023 Frequently Asked Questions:

Is RESET required?

Yes. Each organization desiring to be considered an active and registered organization at Clayton State University must attend RESET training. Attendance is required for returning (active academic previous year) and new organizations.

I am an organization President, and I cannot attend RESET due to extenuating circumstances. What if I cannot attend?

If you are unable to attend RESET you must complete the following steps:

- 1) Email one of the individuals below stating the reason you cannot attend.

(*If you have specific questions about attendance, email or call one of the individuals listed above.)

Are all officers required to attend RESET?

Student organization Presidents are required to attend. One (1) additional officer must attend. Due to the vital information being provided at RESET we *strongly recommend* all students serving as student organization officers for Fall 2023 make it a priority to attend RESET.

I'm an executive board member of more than one student organization. Can I represent more than one organization?

Yes. You may represent more than one student organization although one (1) additional officer must be present for each organization. Rule of thumb: each organization must have at least two (2) officers present at RESET. One officer being the organization President.

Where is RESET being held?

In the Student Activities Center ballrooms.

Why is RESET and the Greek Retreat scheduled on the same day this year?

Campus Life is undergoing organizational changes. To provide optimal service, the department merged the two retreats. The merging of the retreats does not impact the level of content and resources provided at each retreat.

If my organization attends only a half day of RESET is our attendance counted?

No. Campus Life staff will conduct attendance throughout the day of RESET.

Is my advisor required to attend RESET?

No. Advisors receive a separate training and overview session. Campus Life will contact advisors with advisor training details the week following RESET.

Will there be a virtual or hybrid option?

No.

I am the President of more than 1 Student Organization, am I able to attend on behalf of multiple organizations?

Yes. You are allowed to represent more than one organization.

I am attending the Greek Retreat breakout session and I am representing a student organization. How do I decide which session to attend?

The Greek Retreat breakout session begins at 11:30 a.m. If you are representing a Greek organization and a student organization an additional non-Greek officer of your student organization must attend RESET. During breakout sessions non-Greek officers will attend the student organization specific sessions.

I am a member of the Greek community. Am I required to attend RESET?

Greek organization Presidents and one (1) additional executive board member must attend the **FULL DAY RESET** training (9:30 – 4:30 p.m.). All other members of the organization (minimum 80% of Fall 2023 Greek roster) must attend the FSC Greek Retreat breakout **HALF DAY** session (11:30 – 3:00 p.m.)

Am I allowed to attend the second half of RESET if I am a Greek organization member *not* serving in an executive leadership role?

Yes. All organization members are welcome to attend any RESET training session.

Will food be provided at RESET?

Yes. A continental breakfast, snacks, and lunch will be provided at RESET training.

What do I need to bring to RESET?

Below is a list of suggested items to bring:

- items to take notes pen, pencil, notepad, journal, tablet, laptop, etc.
- Jacket or sweater
- Reusable water bottle
