
Desire2Learn: LockDown Browser for iPads (v 10.5)

The Respondus module allows you to manage the settings for each quiz requiring Respondus LockDown Browse. The LockDown Browser is typically used on PC and MAC computers, but is also available for iPads. This tutorial assumes Respondus LockDown Browser is enabled for the course/quiz and the Respondus widget is already added to the active homepage.

Enabling the iPad Edition of LockDown Browser

Use the options located under the Restrictions tab to set up the availability and timing of your quiz.


1. Select the Respondus LockDown Browser tool (dashboard).



2. Select "Modify Settings" for the exam. Click the Restrictions tab.



3. Make sure "Require Respondus LockDown Browser for this exam" is selected and expand the advanced settings. Click "Allow students to take this exam with an iPad" to enable iPad use. Password settings are optional. Be sure to select your desired Monitor Webcam setting and save all changes.



- 4. Provide you student with the following instructions which can be found on Respondus' knowledgebase website:
 - Download and install the "LockDown Browser" app from Apple iTunes to the iPad. (Requires iOS 7 or higher.)
 - Enable iPad's "Guided Access" by selecting iPad > Settings > General > Accessibility >
 Guided Access. Turn on Guided Access and set a passcode (you need to remember this
 passcode to exit Guided Access after an exam). The setup for Guided Access only needs
 to be done once.
 - Start the LockDown Browser app.
 - The first time the app is used, you will be prompted to select your institution and server. (If you later need to change the institution or server, select the settings icon on the LockDown Browser toolbar.)
 - Triple-press the iPad home button to start Guided Access and enter LockDown Browser.
 - After completing the exam, triple-press the home button and enter the passcode to exit Guided Access.
 - Press the Home button again to return to the Home page.
