

**Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund – Minority-Serving Institution Portion
Authorized by Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act**

Information Sheet and Reporting as of September 30, 2020

Clayton State University has been awarded \$ 396,025.00 by the Secretary of Education in association with Section 18004(a) (2) of the CARES Act. The award amount was later increased to \$405,719. The purpose of these funds is to address needs directly related to the coronavirus. This includes the following:

- Defray expenses incurred including lost revenue; reimbursement for expenses already incurred; technology costs associated with a transition to distance education, faculty and staff trainings, and payroll.
- Grants to students for any component of the student’s cost of attendance, as defined under Section 472 of the Higher Education Act, including food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.

Institutional CARES fund cannot be used for:

- Senior administrator and/or executive salaries, benefits, bonuses, contracts, incentives, cash, or other benefit.

As of September 30, 2020, Clayton State University has spent and/or encumbered \$405,218.95 in the following categories:
