





# HOW DOES STUDYING ABROAD BENEFIT YOU?

Think of education abroad as an investment for your future. When approached with intention, you can maximize a global experience to benefit you academically, professionally, and personally.

Students who study abroad can become more culturally sensitive and self-confident. These skills help you build relationships, communicate, and network professionally. By broadening your understanding of your discipline, you also open yourself up to more social mobility and new job markets. Are you uncomfortable with the idea of moving to another state for that dream job after graduation? After living independently in another country, that prospect will now seem exciting and less daunting.

Employers also recognize that definite competencies come with a study abroad experience.
