Auxiliary Organization ban

As of March 2006, Clayton State University does not authorize, recognize or approve of the existence of fraternity or sorority affiliated auxiliary organizations such as: sweethearts, diamonds, little sisters/brothers, courts, kittens, etc.

In instances where the Auxiliary Organization Ban violates a fraternity or sorority's national constitution, the fraternity or sorority must submit official documentation to Clayton State University along with a copy of the constitution indicating that auxiliary organizations are recognized and permitted.

The official documentation must identify how the structure of the partnership exists. In addition, the documentation must outline how the structure is maintained financially.
