PRIORITY RESET* FOR RETURNING STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS ONLY WILL TAKE PLACE ON THURSDAY, JUNE 24TH, 2025 FROM 9:30AM – 2:30PM IN THE SAC BALLROOM.

***Organizations attending the PRIORITY RESET SESSION will have 1st access to Presence & ASTRA**

Is RESET required?

Yes. Each organization desiring to be considered an active and registered organization at Clayton State University must attend RESET training. Attendance is required for returning (active academic previous year) and new organizations.

I am an organization President, Vice President, or Treasurer, and I cannot attend RESET due to extenuating circumstances. What if I cannot attend?

If you are unable to attend RESET, you must complete the following steps:

- 1) Email one of the individuals below stating the reason you cannot attend.

Are all officers required to attend RESET?

Student organization **Presidents, Vice Presidents, and Treasurers are required to attend. ALL** these organization officers must attend. Due to the vital information being provided at RESET we *strongly recommend* all students serving as student organization officers for Fall 2025 make it a priority to attend RESET.

I'm an executive board member of more than one student organization. Can I represent more than one organization?

Yes. You may represent more than one student organization although two (2) additional officers must be present for each organization. Rule of thumb: each organization must have at least three (3) officers (President, Vice President, & Treasurer) present at RESET, even if they represent different organizations (cannot represent the same organization in multiple positions).

If my organization attends only a half day of RESET is our attendance counted?

Will there be a virtual or hybrid option?

No.

Yes. You are allowed to represent more than one organization.

I am a member of the Greek community. Am I required to attend RESET?

Greek organization Presidents, Vice Presidents, and Treasurers must attend the **FULL DAY RESET** training (9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.).

Will food be provided at RESET?

Yes. A continental breakfast, snacks, and lunch will be provided at RESET training.
