1. Description of Request:

During the 2021-22 academic year, the USG raised the rates associated with international student health insurance. Since there was a drastic rise in costs, the system provided a subsidy to returning international students to assist with the increase in health insurance rates. The subsidy was removed for the upcoming 2022-23 academic year leaving many international students in a challenging financial position. We are requesting the subsidy that was provided in 2021-22 to our returning international student-athletes be offered again for the 2022-23 academic year to assist with the increase in insurance costs.
