

AI CoPilot Generated Comparison of Original and Revised Alcohol Policies on 1.24.25

Key Changes in the Revised Alcohol Policy (January 2025):

1. Scope and Locations:

- The original policy specified that alcohol could only be served at the Harry S. Downs Center, Spivey Recital Hall, the Student Activities Center, and James M. Baker University Center¹.
- The revised policy does not limit the locations to these specific venues, allowing for more flexibility in where alcohol can be served on campus².

2. Approval Process:

- The original policy required prior written approval from multiple officials, including the Executive Director of the Harry S. Downs Center, the Director of Spivey Hall, the Director of the Student Activities Center, the Vice President of Business & Operations, and the President of Clayton State University¹.
- The revised policy simplifies this process by requiring only the President's written approval².

3. Alcohol Types and Service:

- The original policy allowed only wine and beer to be served, with all alcohol provided by the client¹.
- The revised policy does not specify the types of alcohol allowed, potentially permitting a broader range of alcoholic beverages².

4. Wristband Requirement:

- The revised policy introduces a wristband requirement for individuals consuming alcohol, which was not mentioned in the original policy².

5. Security and Monitoring:

- The revised policy includes detailed procedures for security and monitoring, such as the requirement for a campus police officer to attend any event serving alcohol and the prohibition of outside containers and cups².
- The original policy mentioned the need for a Public Safety officer at events with more than 100 individuals but did not provide as much detail on security measures¹.

6. Communication and Enforcement:

- The revised policy emphasizes communication of the alcohol policies to attendees before and during the event, including pre-event promotional materials, tickets, and event signage².
- The original policy did not specify these communication requirements¹.

7. Associated Policies and Regulations:

- The revised policy includes references to various Board of Regents policies and Georgia state laws related to alcohol use².
- The original policy did not include these references¹.
