III. Officer Reports

- President: Town Hall Meeting Proposal- President Jamian Watson proposed the idea of having a mock town hall meeting for students to attend. This town hall meeting will serve as a expediter for student questions and concerns because different departments on campus will be in attendance. SGA voted to have this town hall meeting but no specific date was discussed.
- Vice President: Casual T-Shirt – Vice President Lambert discussed the idea of purchasing casual t-shirts for SGA. Students will be asked to pay for their own t-shirt because it is not mandatory. More details will come later.
- Secretary: Methods of Communication- Secretary Eubanks has asked SGA members to communicate with her through email instead of “group me” when regarding absences.
- Treasurer: Budget Review & SGA Shirts Update- Treasurer Rainey went over the new budget amount after the SGA retreat. She also elaborated on the new SGA shirts that will be purchased. They will be short sleeved polos and SGA members will not have to purchase them.

IV. Chair Reports

- Student Affairs: SGA “Meet & Greet” Proposal- The Student Affairs committee proposed the idea of having a SGA Meet & Greet on Mainstreet that will serve as the student body’s first time contact with the SGA senators. The student body voted to have this event.
- Academic Affairs: The Student Affairs committee talked about future student concerns that they will be tackling including the lack of science tutors on campus and straws on campus.
- Internal Affairs: Senator of the Month Proposal & SGA Thursdays- The Internal Affairs committee had two proposals this week. For the first one, Senator of the Month, they proposed the idea of having a senator of the month that will be chosen by the Cabinet. This award will create excitement in SGA and it will make members work a little harder. The second proposal, SGA Thursdays, will occur every Thursday on Mainstreet and it will be a recording of SGA members asking the student body questions about topics on campus. This will allow SGA to receive direct feedback from the students. Both of these proposals were approved.
- Fiscal Affairs: Proposal- The Fiscal Affairs committee proposed the idea of having a Breast Cancer Awareness Table on Mainstreet for the month of October. The table will have candy, trivia questions and a donation box. All donations will go to an organization called the “Pink Fund”. This event will be headed by Committee Chair Careese Coulzie. The proposal was voted on and approved.

V. Old Business

- Retreat Feedback- President Watson went over the feedback that was given on the surveys for the past SGA retreat. Overall the retreat was a success and minor changes will be made for the next one.
- Voters Registration Table- President Watson talked about the results of the voter registration table. Over 70 people were registered to vote.

VI. New Business

- Appointing of Senate Lead, Fiscal Affairs Chair & Graduate Affairs Chair- Senators Eba and Careese, Mikelyn were appointed in to their new Cabinet positions.
- Volunteer Opportunities: “Make a Difference Day” & Morrow Fall Festival- The E-board briefly discussed SGA being a participant in Make a Difference Day occurring on October 26th and the Morrow Fall Festival.
