He discussed the vaccination and how receiving a shot is an approach to the 'new normal' in the fall. Additionally, he shared his story regarding the shots, as he has gotten both as of date. Many concerns and questions were asked by SGA Cabinet members, such as 'is the shot mandatory by the University?' The University has the vaccine as COVID-19 is deemed as an emergency, but the University cannot require. However, as a student body, we should receive it as it is free. The University will reopen in the fall of 2021.

Dr. Hynes also discussed the University's decision to mirror last year's fall semester by closing school by Thanksgiving. 
Advisor Report:
