SERVICES FUNDED BY THE FEE

The Clayton State Department of Athletics serves as an auxiliary unit of Clayton State University. The department supports 140+ student-athletes, 16 full-time employees, and 9 part-time/graduate assistants, in addition to interns, student workers, game day personnel, and volunteers. The Clayton State athletics program is a member of the NCAA DII and Peach Belt Conference. We currently sponsor eleven sports, which are:

Men's and Women's Basketball, Men's and Women's Soccer, Men's Golf, Men's and Women's Cross Country, and Men's and Women's Indoor and Outdoor Track and Field. Although not a NCAA sport, the Cheerleading team is housed under the umbrella of the Department of Athletics.

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ATHLETICS FEE USAGE

Projection – Student fees account for 93% of the FY20 athletics budget. Services provided by this fee include, but are not limited to:

- Personnel
- Travel
- Operations
- Supplies
- Uniforms and equipment
- Scholarships

- Medical insurance and related expenses
- NCAA and PBC memberships
- Recruiting
- Officials
- Facility enhancements

Students enrolled full-time will be assessed a \$170 per semester athletics fee. Students enrolled part-time (3 credits or less) will be assessed an \$85 per semester athletics fee. Students enrolled in Henry County and Peachtree City locations will be assessed a \$85 athletics fee. Senior citizens, military, and FT/PT online program students will not be assessed an athletics fee.

Anticipated Budget Changes
